Temporary Road Closure

Bathurst Light Car Club - NSW State Hillclimb Championships

The public is advised that **part of Mount Panorama** Motor Racing Circuit will be **closed** to traffic on **Saturday 1 March and Sunday 2 March 2025**, between the hours of **7am and 6pm**, to allow the Bathurst Light Car Club to conduct two rounds of the NSW State Hillclimb Championships.

Essex Hillclimb – Saturday 1 March 2025 – from the high side of Bathurst Goldfields' gates on Conrod Straight up to and including McPhillamy Park gates on Skyline. Alternate access to McPhillamy Park will be via Barry Gurdon Drive until 12 noon, thereafter via the rear access road off College Road near the Waste Management Centre.

Mountain Straight Hillclimb – Sunday 2 March 2025 – from the area known as Hell Corner at the commencement of Mountain Straight to the eastern side of McPhillamy Park entrance on Skyline. Alternate access to the top of Mount Panorama will be via Barry Gurdon Drive.
