#### Amendments to Section 7.11 Development Contributions Plans

Council has placed on public exhibition amendments to four (4) of its Section 7.11 Development Contribution Plans, including:

- 1. Bathurst Regional Community Facilities
- 2. Roadworks New Residential Subdivisions
- 3. Bathurst Regional Open Space
- 4. Raglan Creek Stormwater Drainage

Amendments have been made to each of the Plans to:

- I. Update legislative references.
- 2. Change the indexation rate by which contribution rates are updated each year from an annual CPI change to a quarterly CPI update.

The purpose of the amendments is to:

- I. Ensure the plans reflect current legislation.
- 2. Ensure that the Development Contribution rates remain closely representative of infrastructure
