

Temporary Road Closure Bathurst Winter Festival

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place for the 2024 Bathurst Winter Festival.

- Closure of **Russell Street** between William Street and George Street from **6am Thursday 27 June to 6am Saturday 27 July**. Pedestrian access will remain to the Civic Centre, Bathurst Court House and Historical Society building. Vehicle access will remain to Court House Lane for authorised vehicles.
- Closure of **Church Street** between William Street and George Street **6am Saturday 6 July to 6am Monday 8 July and 6am Friday 12 July to 6am Monday 15 July**. Businesses and residents who use the Scott Centre car park will have access via the gate next to the post office on Howick Street.
- **No parking on Russell Street** between William Street and George Street from **3pm Wednesday 26 June**.
- **No parking on Church Street** between William Street and George Street from **3pm Friday 5 July; 3pm Wednesday 10 July; and 3pm Thursday 11 July**.
- Relocation of **Russell Street taxi zone** to the existing taxi zone Church Street from **Thursday 27 June to Saturday 27 July**, and relocated to the corner of George Street & Russell Street, across from the Western Advocate on **6, 7, 12, 13 and 14 July**.
- Relocation of **Russell Street bus zone** from near the Court House to Russell Street in front of Steele & Co from **Thursday 27 June to Saturday 27 July**.
- A designated **accessible parking zone** will be located on the corner of **George Street and Russell Street** and on the William Street end of Kings Parade from **Thursday 27 June to Saturday 27 July**. An **additional disabled parking zone** will be located on Church Street for Accessibility Day from **6am to 9pm on Thursday 11 July 2024**.
