An Extra-Ordinary Meeting of Bathurst Regional Council will be held in the Council Chamber, Civic Centre, Bathurst on **Thursday 10 October 2024 at 2pm**. This meeting is being held for the election of the Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

Temporary Road Closure

2024 Repco Bathurst 1000

Track Closures: The **Mount Panorama Motor Racing Circuit** will be closed from approximately **6am on Saturday 6 October to 2pm Monday 14 October 2024**, to control the movement of spectators:

- Mountain Straight – just above the entrance to the Paddock Camping Area.
- Conrod Straight – just above Murray's Corner.

Persons wishing to gain access to the Track should enter via Panorama Avenue and Pit Straight.

Admission gates commence operations from approximately **7am on Thursday 10 October until Sunday 13 October 2024**.

Traffic Management Plan: Traffic will be controlled on **Panorama Avenue, Havannah Street and Lloyds Road** from approximately **5am on Thursday 10 October until 2pm Monday 14 October 2024**.

Residents: Under direction from the Clerk of the Course, access for residents will be facilitated through Murray's Corner at specific breaks during the racing schedule. Correspondence outlining all access arrangements will be distributed to residents directly.

2024 Repco Bathurst 1000 Race Week Off Track Events

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place for Race Week Events.

- **Closure** of **Russell Street and Church Street** between William Street and George Street from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024 to 6am Thursday 10 October 2024 and 6am Friday 11 October 2024 to 6am Saturday 12 October 2024**.
- **Closure** of **William Street** between Church Street and Russell Street from **4.30pm to 7pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **No parking** on **Russell Street and Church Street** between William Street and Russell Street from **4pm Tuesday 8 October 2024 and 4pm Thursday 10 October 2024**.
- **No parking** on **William Street between Church Street and Russell Street** from **6am to 7.30pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **No parking** on **William Street between Russell Street and BMEC** from **6am to 7.30pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **Caution tape** will be in place along **William Street** between Russell and Keppel Street from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024** for pedestrian safety and will be removed immediately after the parade has finished.
- To ensure spectators remain a safe distance from moving vehicles, **crowd control barriers** will be put in place along the **corner of Russell Street and William Street and Russell Street and George Street** from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **Temporary relocation** of the **Russell and Church Street Taxi Ranks to George Street** (across from the Western Advocate) on **Wednesday 9 October 2024 and Friday 11 October 2024**.
- **Disabled parking** installed on **William Street between Church Street and Howick Street** on **Wednesday 9 October 2024** and on **William Street between Church Street and Russell Street** (next to the permanent disabled parking space) on **Friday 11 October 2024**.

2024 Koori Knockout - Expected Heavy Traffic

Council advises that Hereford Street will be subject to **heavy traffic and pedestrian congestion** during the period **Friday 4 October 2024 to Monday 7 October 2024** due to the Koori Knockout Event which is to be held at the **Hereford Street Sporting Fields**.

Drivers are encouraged to avoid the area where possible.

Mitre and Howick Street Roundabout Works

Bathurst Regional Council recently received Federal Government 'Black Spot' grant funding to improve the safety of the Mitre & Howick Streets roundabout.

The funding of \$445,000 will address the following proposed reconstruction works:

- Removal and replacement of the existing centre island apron with a larger apron. The central landscaped part of the centre island will remain unchanged.
- Removal and reconstruction of all existing splitter islands to remove slip lanes and increase pedestrian refuge space at crossings.
- The centre island apron and splitter island reconstruction works include level adjustments to improve drainage and road pavement crossfall.
- Milling of existing road surface and placement of new asphalt to match the new larger centre island and road pavement alignment/levels and provide a smooth and high grip driving surface.
- New line marking and signage relocation to suit the new roundabout geometry.

Works will **commence on Tuesday 15 October 2024**, requiring full closure of the roundabout for the first 3-weeks of the initial reconstruction work. Residential driveways adjacent to the work site will remain accessible.

In total, the works are expected to take 6 -10 weeks with completion anticipated by Friday 20 December 2024. Following the initial 3-week full road closure, the road will be reopened to traffic in accordance with traffic control conditions while the remainder of the works are completed.
