16 Item 1 AMENDMENT TO BLUE RIDGE ESTATE DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN (DCP) (20.00077)

The Director Environmental, Planning & Building Services provided a brief history of the Blue Ridge Estate Development Control Plan proposed change.

Discussion included:

<u>S Shiels</u> - Lot 19 Blue Ridge Estate - only concern is impact on their block of the change, due to the shape of that block. The house they wish to build must be well set back on the block. Request their block stays as it is, due to the uniqueness of the block.

<u>M Warren - Littlebourne</u> - live at front of estate. When Estate first proposed concern at traffic up and down the road. This proposal means an extra 7 lots and will create further problems. Need to look at access onto White Rock Road.

<u>B O'Connell</u> - Lot 4 Blue Ridge Estate - have bought a lot in the Estate. The proposal will affect their ability to build on the block. Wish to be able to utilise their block and in favour of removal.

<u>B Goddard</u> - Landowner, Blue Ridge Estate - the modification to the DCP will impact on his land. Spoke of history of water access issues. Noted flexibility needed with setbacks. In favour of the proposal.

<u>**K** Peterson</u> - does not have details of proposal. Blue Ridge was developed on basis of rural/residential subdivision. Any future subdivision will defeat this purpose.

<u>1 DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT - PROMOTING BETTER PRACTICE</u> <u>REVIEW REPORT (NOVEMBER 2006) (03.00142)</u>

<u>Recommendation</u>: That Council note the updated report (as at May 2010) of the Department of Local Government, PBP Review of November 2006.

<u>Report</u>: As Councillors would be aware, in November 2006, the Department of Local Government undertook a Promoting Better Practice Review of the Council. The Review Report and initial responses were presented to Council at its meeting on 16 May 2007 (General Manager's Report No 1). Follow-up reports have been provided to Council at its meetings of 3 September 2008, 1 April 2009 and 30 September 2009.

The purpose of this item is to provide an ongoing report on how Council is addressing the recommendations contained within the review. At <u>Attachment 1</u> is an Action Plan/Status Report which provides a Progress Report on each recommendation. It is considered the results of the Review were extremely pleasing. A number of the recommendations have progressed:

1. Recommendation 1

The State Government has issued guidelines on Long Term Financial Planning. Bathurst Regional Council has been gazetted for inclusion in Group 3.

2. Recommendations 11 and 12

The Audit Committee has now met - 31.3.2010. A Charter is in place for operation of the Committee.

3. Recommendations 13 and 16

Development of the new LEP which has been delayed due to, amongst other things, the Government's recent Rural Land Inquiry (Recommendations 13, 16) and inability of Department to sign off on various strategies. Scheduled completion date is now 2011.

4. Recommendation 22

Review Business Plans water and sewer, Recommendation No 22. These have now been completed.

5. Recommendation 24 and 25

Asset Management Plans, Recommendations 24 and 25 - Development is ongoing as is noted in the attachment to the report.

Financial Implications: Actions are being taken within existing budgets.

6 ART DEVELOPMENT (11.00006)


Cr Carpenter - request Council consider including an Art Policy component in major works.

1 PUBLIC HEARING - DRAFT BATHURST REGIONAL (INTERIM) LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN 2005 (AMENDMENT NO. 3) AND DRAFT BATHURST LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN (CLASSIFICATION AND RECLASSIFICATION OF PUBLIC LAND) 1997 (AMENDMENT NO. 4) (20.00155)

<u>Recommendation</u>: That the information be noted.

<u>Report</u>: Council has resolved to prepare draft Local Environmental Plans in respect Part Lot 88, DP 249485, Durack Close, West Bathurst, Lot 22, DP 864274, Mid Western Highway, Robin Hill, Part Lot 33, DP 593108, Gilmour Street, Kelso, Part Lot 224, DP 735655, Tyndall Street, Kelso and Part Lot 274, DP 735655, Elm Place, Kelso.

The effect of the draft Plans is to reclassify Part Lot 33, DP 593108, Part Lot 224, DP 735655, Part Lot 88, DP 249485, Lot 22, DP 864274 and Part Lot 274, DP 735655 from community land to operational land under the Local Government Act 1993. The draft Plans will also change the zoning of Part Lot 88, DP 249485, Durack Close, West Bathurst and Part Lot 33, DP 593108, Gilmour Street, Kelso from 6(a) Local Recreation to 2(a) Residential.

The draft Plans were placed on public exhibition for a period of 28 days from 28 September 2009 to 27 October 2009. Council received 2 submission in relation to the draft Plans (**<u>attachment 1</u>**). One submission was in favour of the draft Plans and one submission raised concerns relating to the diversion bank within the subject land at Mid Western Highway, although it did not oppose the draft Plan.

Council has considered the submissions that were received and considers that they relate to the diversion bank rather than directly objecting to the reclassification of the land at the Mid Western Highway. Further discussions will be held with the affected landowners relating to the reinstatement of the diversion bank as part of the creation of the Right of Carriageway.

Public Hearing

Pursuant to section 69 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 and section 29 of the Local Government Act 1993, a public hearing must be held with respect to the classification and reclassification of public land through a local environmental plan.

Whilst this matter has been previously considered by Council, a public hearing had not been held as required. Hence the hearing has been scheduled and the matter will be referred back to Council for reconsideration at its next meeting.

Financial Implications: Nil.
