Background

Resulting from the untimely death of Peter Brock in September 2006, Mount Panorama became a pilgrimage for Brock's fans. In particular Brock's Sykline was the focal point for many of his fans to pay their respects. In late 2006 Council commissioned local photographer, Peter Gumpert to capture the thoughts and memories of peter Brock's fans who had left their messages on Brock's Skyline.

Policy

- (a) the profits that result from any sales of the photographic images of the written tributes to Peter Brock be used to assist funding of the Peter Brock memorial statue; and
- (b) upon the costs of the memorial statue being funded, that future profits be split 50% to each of the Brock Foundation and the operations of the National Motor Racing Museum Brock Wing.
